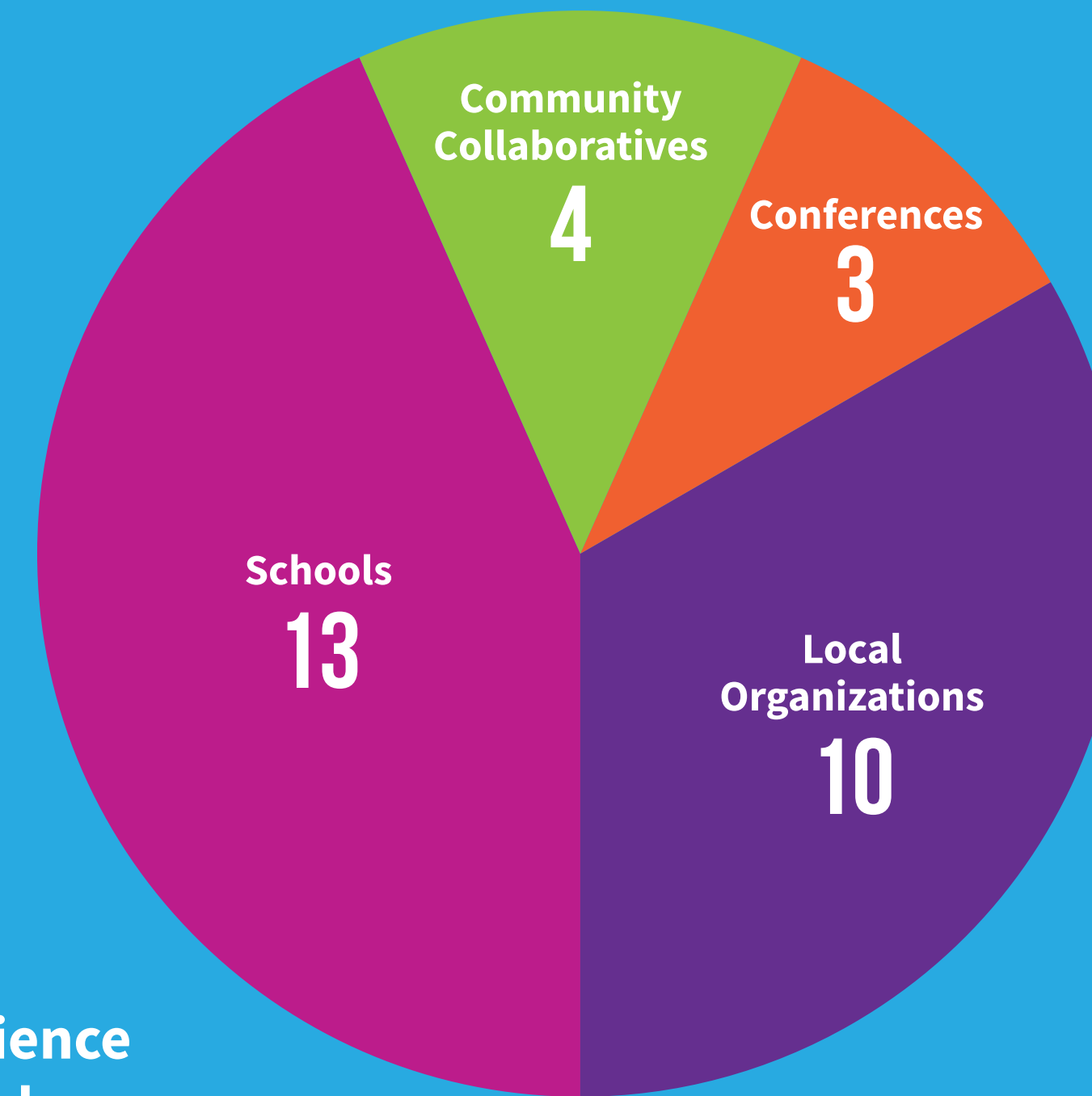
TRAININGS ON NEAR SCIENCE FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Resilient Wilco trainers held trainings on NEAR Science at stakeholder organizations and for parents of high school and pre-school students.

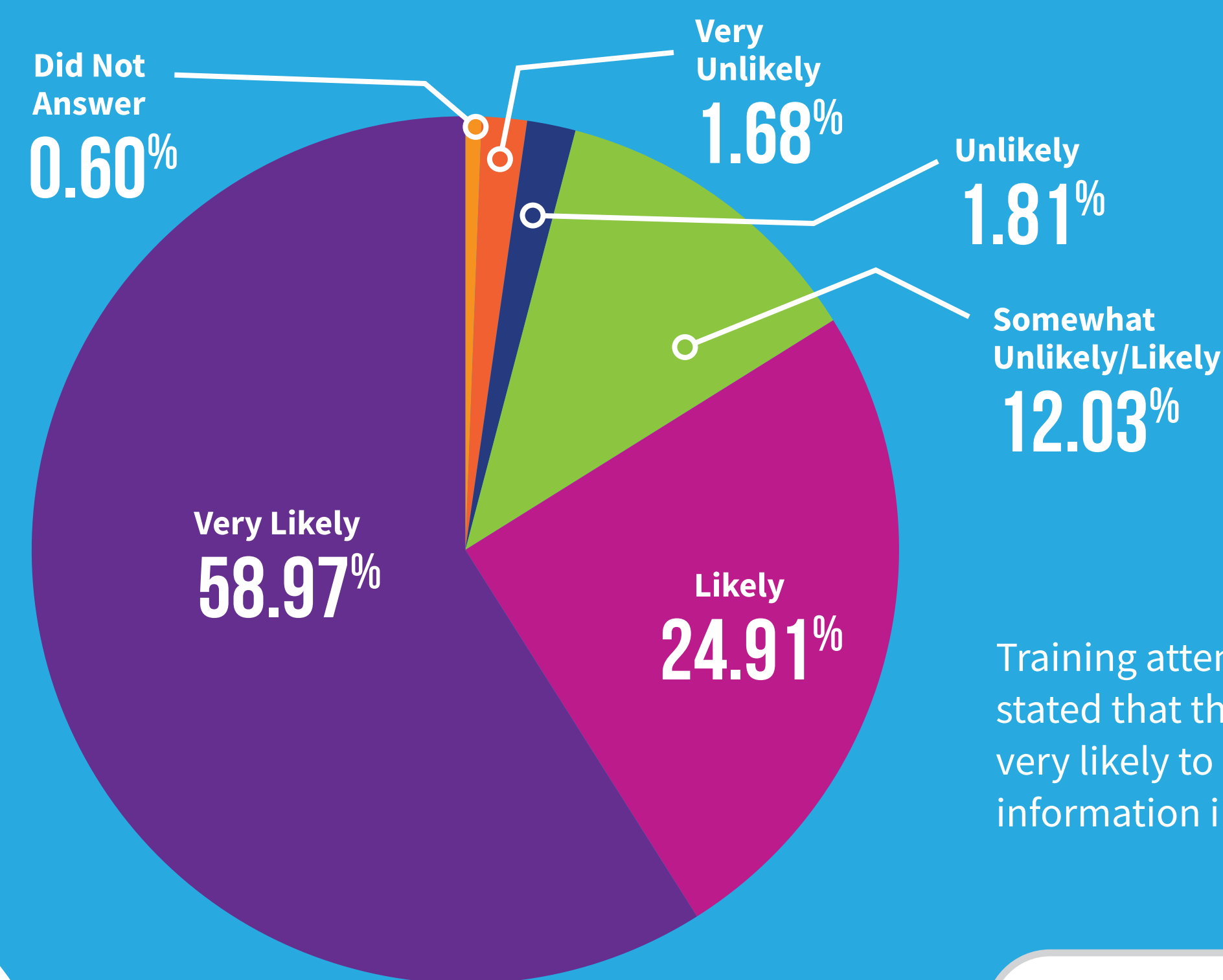
The NEAR Science training is a thought-provoking overview of breakthroughs in neuroscience and epigenetics research that is meant to expand attendees' understanding of how experiences in childhood can shape human biology. The training includes key insights and compelling data from the ACEs study, along with an introduction to the science of resilience.

With GHF funding, Resilient Wilco enhanced communication, collected and analyzed data, developed branded communication materials, coordinated trainings, and developed processes for new trainers.

The human capital provided by Resilient Wilco team members Matt Smith, Linda Meigs and Suzy Pukys has been instrumental in launching Resilient Wilco. Their connection to the community, their success in relationship building and networking and their strategic planning have enabled Resilient Wilco to move from a book study on community resilience to a cross sector collaboration to improve youth outcomes across the county. Much of the work they supported in Resilient Wilco became the launching pad for a project with UT Austin called STEP UP Texas. This work has focused our efforts in Williamson County, enabled us to receive grant funding through the Department of Justice, and is now supporting us in our statewide application for additional communities to join us in our efforts to improve youth outcomes.
